From September 2 onwards school was in session from Nursery to Grades 14. Social distancing was maintained in every classroom, wash basins were fixed at three entry points and many hand sanitization facilities were placed throughout the school giving easy access to students, staff & visitors. In line with the ministry requirements the school has not been permitted to date to resume sports activities and to re-open daycare, cafeteria and sports complex.
