NEWS FROM THE TRUSTS CHAPEL TRUST

The Chapel Trust, with the aid of donations from the LC'ites in Canada, funded the installation of 3 large exhaust fans in the chapel, 2 tablets in memory of Ms. Simon and Mrs. Gunawardana, and the printing of order-of-service booklets for the Chapel, during the past year.

In order for the Chapel Trust to undertake the annual maintenance of the Chapel over the next few years, we would need further donations of Rs 200,000 to raise the Trust Fund to Rs I million.
